




Japanese Trade (2007)

JETRO's Activities in Europe

- 1. Supplying Japan with European economic information
- 2. Promoting business alliance mainly in High-Tech sector
- 3. Promoting foreign direct investment (FDI) into Japan
- 4. Boosting Japan's exports
- 5. Supporting facilitation of business activities of Japanese companies in Europe

- <u>Esor S.r.l.</u> is a member of IQT, nonprofit organization which promotes global business. On behalf of IQT, Esor opened a Japanese branch in 2007
