- **Civil Society (mainly Volunteers)**


# **Mandate**

**It deals with:**


- Forecasting









*Seismic activity during the first two weeks*


6 April, 2009 – 3.32 a.m.

## Earthquake figures

- **308 victims (22 children < 16 y.o.)**
- **1500+ injured**
- **62.543 homeless (28.579 in 5.553 tents, 33964 in 518 hotels and 2225 private houses)**
- **44.000+ buildings to be inspected in the area of Intensity VI (MCS scale). From the first 40700+ surveys, about 30% of the building inspected results unusable**
